Journeyman Responsibilities:

- Perform project supervision under the direction of a Construction Manager and Site Superintendent
- Assist in Site Superintendent in any project management
- Assist in Quality Control and quality assurance for projects
- Self-performing trades as directed by construction project manager (see below for responsibilities)
- Prepare progress reports and issue progress schedules to Construction Manager and Site Superintendent
- Project Picture Logging, if needed
- Maintaining Job Site Safety
- Perform operations on job sites such as:
 - Framing
 - Concrete Forms
 - Demolition/Excavation
 - Trenching
 - Backfilling
 - Fencing
 - Saw-Cutting
 - Core-Drilling
 - Concrete & Asphalt
- Lifting: Exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 20 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 10 pounds of force constantly to move objects as well as raising objects from a lower to higher position or moving objects horizontally from position-to-position
- Walking: Moving about on foot to accomplish tasks, particularly for long distances or moving from one work site to another

Minimum Qualifications:

1. Minimum of 1-2 years of experience.
2. Willing to work with a team, ability to be flexible and self-starting, able to make our clients and guests feel welcome
